

Youth and Children's Coordinator

The Anglican Parish of North Pine (NPAC) is looking to hire someone to help us nurture a close-knit group of committed believers who serve Jesus in our community.

The Youth Coordinator and the Children's Coordinator are the two roles that make up this hybrid position. Depending on the chosen candidate and their availability, the job can be split into two parts of ten hours each or combined for a total of twenty hours per week. Someone pursuing theological training or prior experience working with children and young people would be a good fit for this job. There is also the possibility of this position becoming a youth ministry role.

We are a thriving Bible-based Anglican church, in Brisbane's outer north, with a solid dedication to evangelism and youth and children's ministry. The parish has a strong evangelical tradition and embraces a contemporary style of worship. Our primary location is in Petrie, close to the University of the Sunshine Coast.

You will have the opportunity to journey with an enthusiastic group of young people and help them go deeper into their faith.

No Fences

We want our youth group to have a family-like atmosphere where individuals care about one another and develop genuine, trustworthy relationships. Because this group is not exclusive, we don't want to put up any barriers that would prevent others from joining. We recognise that we are a part of a larger church and that engaging with individuals and organisations outside our church is crucial to being a Christian.

Going Deeper

We want the young people in our care to interact regularly with Jesus. Therefore, a significant portion of your leadership will encourage our young people to read the Bible and have a respectful dialogue to change their hearts and minds. These pursuits will occur during our Friday night youth group, camp, and private times with God.

Biblical

Since we have a solid commitment to the Bible, it will be crucial for you to develop a curriculum that enables our students to think and act in a way consistent with the Scriptures.

Prayer

We are aware of God's desire for us to pray, and we want prayer to be a part of every area of our lives and for our leaders to model it.

Life Changing

As a youth leader, you will help us provide our youth with the resources and opportunities they need as the Spirit empowers them to glorify Jesus and serve in his Kingdom.

Adaptive

We acknowledge God's sovereignty and the reality that the Spirit operates according to his pleasure. We, therefore, want you to be flexible and receptive to new opportunities as he leads.

CHILDREN'S COORDINATOR

You will demonstrate servant leadership as our Children's Coordinator by assisting our children in developing a more profound love for God. They will be encouraged by you to read the Bible and pray regularly.

Additionally, you'll find, organise, and train a team of volunteers to help with Kids Church on Sunday.

Since we know that kids don't come to church alone, a large part of your job will be reaching out to parents and helping them educate their children in the faith. Making connections with brand-new families who join the church is also vital.

Finding, choosing, and putting into practice a Sunday school curriculum that will help our kids think and act appropriately in light of our adherence to the Bible will be a priority.

Contributors To Success

To succeed in one or both of these roles, you must be a committed Christian who has an authentic relationship with Jesus and loves working with children and young people. You will need to be confident that the Word of God contains what is sufficient for salvation and satisfied that the Word of God is significant for today. You will want to see people won for Christ and see young people make bold decisions of faith.

You will enjoy being part of a team and be comfortable working with people of different backgrounds and cultures. On a practical level, you will need to have an affinity with children, young people and their families. Good communication and time management skills will also be essential.
